How Restrictions On Bail (RoB) works and how it can help you

- If you are charged and sent to court with a positive drugs test you will be eligible for “Restrictions on Bail”
- This means that you have an opportunity for bail if you agree to attend Drug Intervention Services in order to get help for your drug use.
- Once at court you will be seen by a RoB drugs worker who will explain to you how RoB works and its benefits to you.



1 our aim

We aim to help you to help yourself leave the cycle of crime and drug using.

It is **VERY IMPORTANT** to remember that DIP services **ARE NOT** law enforcement!

2 what happens if I get RoB

You will need to attend **ALL** appointments given to you by the DIP team until your next court date, where the case is reviewed.

3 if you DO NOT turn up

... with a reasonable explanation you can be breached for this and a warrant can be issued for your arrest by the Police.!
