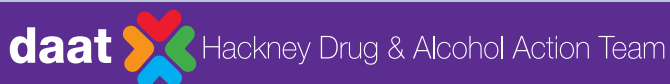

What is the Drug Interventions Programme (DIP)?

- The DAAT Criminal Justice Team / Drug Interventions Programme is a government strategy designed to break the cycle between problematic drug use and crime.
- The DIP team is made up of drug workers based in Stoke Newington and Shoreditch Police Stations, Thames Magistrates Court and in the community at Tudor Grove.
- The DIP is here to bridge the gap between assessment and referral from the Criminal Justice System (CJS) and effective engagement into structured treatment.
- It is the first step for individuals to address their problems regarding drugs and other related issues.

Our Aim:

- Our main aim is to engage, support and stabilise drug misusing offenders, with the view to fast tracking referral onto structured treatment.
- We offer a brief intervention model of assessment, stabilisation and referral.

Referral Criteria:

- Referrals into DIP predominantly come from Arrest Referral or CARAT within HM Prisons. Additionally, if a client is awarded restrictions

on bail (ROB) the court workers will refer them to DIP.

- Clients can attend if they have had recent contact with the CJS.
- Clients >18 or over
- Class A drug as their main problematic drug.
- Hackney resident for funded treatment or referral to services in borough of residence.

What we offer:

- Advice & information for treatment services available.
- Safer Injection and Harm Minimisation.
- 1 to 1 keyworking
- 6-8 weeks structured intervention.
- Alcohol Assessment
- Young Peoples Arrest Referral Assessment and Referral
- Access to DIP Rapid prescribing service.
- BBV & Health Advice.
- Referral to psychosocial counselling
- Housing Advice.
- Mentoring.
- Access to Crack/stimulant specific services
- Referral to Residential & Detox facilities
- Referral to Alcohol Services
- Legal Advice
- Education, Training and Employment Advice
